
Yeah, yeah, the idle presses have been * pumping well over a year now! Blow out the candles.

With healthy steepness, powerful sink, and weird little channel, remember to bring guts when travelling here. Not easily adaptable.


That reminds me of the time I had just finished sessioning a short wall beside




Two cases of selection: At the school the only point of attention was the ramps, at the ditch it was the table. (For some reason Micheal at the EZ7 got on this page.)

Twas to be a ditch contest, and a nice ditch at that - three mild ditches that intersect in the






We're not completely sure, but it may be a ramp. Scott copes.


